

## [University College] Fall 2026 Add/Drop Adjustments for Academic English and a General Elective

Hello, this is the University College Administration Team.

Considering the current enrollment situation for Fall 2026, the enrollment restrictions for certain Academic English sections will be relaxed and the capacities of selected Academic English and General Elective sections will be increased.

Students who wish to register should review the information below and make any necessary course registration or section changes themselves during the official add/drop period.

### 1. Removal of Restrictions for Certain Academic English I Intermediate Sections

- Intermediate-level students who are retaking or have not yet completed the course may also register

※ This exceptional adjustment applies only to the five sections listed above. The existing restrictions will remain in place for all other Academic English I Intermediate sections.

- Year-specific add/drop period: Wednesday, September 2, 2026, 18:30 – Thursday, September 3, 2026, 12:00
- General add/drop period: Thursday, September 3, 2026, 18:30 – Friday, September 4, 2026, 12:00

※ The opening time for the year-specific add/drop period may vary by year of study. Please check the registration schedule applicable to you.

## 4. Important Notes

- Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis and is subject to seat availability. The removal of restrictions or an increase in capacity does not guarantee registration for any particular student.
- Students must make all course registrations and section changes themselves through the course registration system during the official add/drop period.
- Even if a student has discussed enrollment with an instructor or received the instructor's permission to enroll or recommendation to change sections, the student is not automatically registered and a seat is not reserved.
- To ensure a fair and orderly registration process, please understand that neither the University College Administration Team nor an instructor can manually enroll a student in a particular section on the basis of an instructor's permission, recommendation, or an individual discussion with the student.
- The existing eligibility requirements and capacities will remain unchanged for sections not listed above.
- Please check the course registration system for the final class time, classroom, and other course information.
